

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF SECTION 41(j) OF THE NEW YORK STATE RETIREMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY LAW

Resolution # 8 of 2026

WHEREAS, the TOWN BOARD of the TOWN OF NEW HAVEN, desires to provide to certain employees with the optional allowance for unused sick leave benefit provided for under Section 41(j) of the New York State Retirement and Social Security Law; and,

WHEREAS, this section allows for the crediting of unused, unpaid sick leave by the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System (NYSLRS) upon an employee's retirement; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of New Haven is a participating employer in NYSLRS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of New Haven does hereby elect to provide the benefit of Section 41(j) of the Retirement and Social Security Law, to all employees who are members of the Teamsters Local 317 Bargaining Unit with the Town of New Haven Highway Department; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this benefit shall apply to accumulated, unused, and unpaid sick leave, not to exceed a maximum of 165 days (or 100 days for members who first become members of a public retirement system on or after April 1, 2012) to be used for the purpose of computing additional service credit upon retirement, as set forth in Section 41(j);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the State Comptroller and the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System, and with any other entity which may properly require notice hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
